Indiana prison locations and statistics

Of the state's 24 adult prisons and holding facilities, the Department of Correction contracts with six outside agencies for inmate beds. The largest privately run prison is the New Castle Correctional Facility with more than 2,400 beds. The others are mostly work-release agencies. Nearly a quarter of the 28,000 adult inmates held at the end of 2010 came from Marion County, the state's most populous county. Next were Allen and Elkhart counties, with each providing 10 percent of the prison population. The largest prisons, those holding more than 3,000 inmates, are Westville Correctional in LaPorte County and Miami Correctional in Miami County.
